Fetakgomo Tubatse Local Municipality (FTLM) is a legal permit holder for the establishment and operation of Malogeng Landfill Site (Malogeng Landfill). The site is located on farm Diamand 422 KS in Malogeng fields, which is situated at about 4 km South of R37. The site can be accessed via R37 from Polokwane or Burgersfort and D4190 (gravel road) from Ga-Nkwana. The landfill is for general waste, which comes from the local communities, local clinics, shopping areas and the mines within the municipal jurisdiction

### Background on the project

FTLM intends to appoint an independent external auditor/environmental assessment practitioner to undertake an annual environmental performance assessment/environmental audit at Malogeng Landfill Site. The successful auditor will be expected to produce an external environmental performance within a period of two weeks after appointment. The project covers an extent area of 10ha.

#### **Project**

All prospective service providers who wish to undertake this project are required to conduct a site visit before submission of their proposals. It will be obligatory to undertake all agreed work as per specification stipulated bellow.

## 3.1 Specification

- State whether conditions of permit are adhered to:
- Assess internal quarterly performance report/operation and maintenance report;
- Assess landfill committee findings and recommendations (monthly minutes;
- Assess Environmental Impact Report;
- Consider all communication received from competent authority;
- Include an interpretation of all available data and test results regarding the operation
  of the site and its impacts on the environment;

- Specify target dates for the implementation of the recommendations by the permit holder to achieve compliance and safe environment;
- Contain recommendations regarding non-compliance or potential non-compliance and must specify target dates for the implementation of recommendations by the permit holder and whether corrective action taken for the previous audit noncompliance was adequate;
- Show monitoring results graphically and conduct trend analysis;
- The environmental assessment practitioner must be registered with South African Council for Natural Scientific Professions and attached up to date certified copy of membership card;
- He/she or within the team must have certificate for ISO14001 for Environmental Audit:
- Must have conducted at least one or two similar projects. Attach completion certificate or letter from their relevant client;
- Produce an electronical and hard copy of the audit report; and
- Provide water monitoring samples in accordance with method prescribed by and obtainable from the South African Bureau of Standards (SABS) for three boreholes onsite. Chemical information required for boreholes is enclosed as Annexure 1.

#### Time frames

The audit and water monitoring will be expected to be completed within a period of two weeks after appointment.
