Bidders must obtain a minimum score (required) of points allocated for functionality to qualify for further evaluation

- Bid documents will be on sale for a non-refundable fee of R300.00 after the briefing sessions and on the 27th October 2017 for tender no FGTM/F40/17/18, at the Cashier's Office, Fetakgomo-Greater Tubatse Municipality, Lower Ground, 1st Kastania Street, Burgersfort, from 08H30 to 15H00 during week-days.
