The Milky Way Stargazing Programme is a signature camp activity, held on clear evenings at Potlake Nature Reserve — one of the darkest skies in Limpopo Province, far from urban light pollution. Participants will observe the Milky Way core, lunar features, visible planets, and deep-sky objects using the AstroFold 4K Pro. 4K footage captured during sessions will be projected on the inflatable outdoor screen the following morning as part of the astronomy education debrief.
